## Buddy Bee or Bully



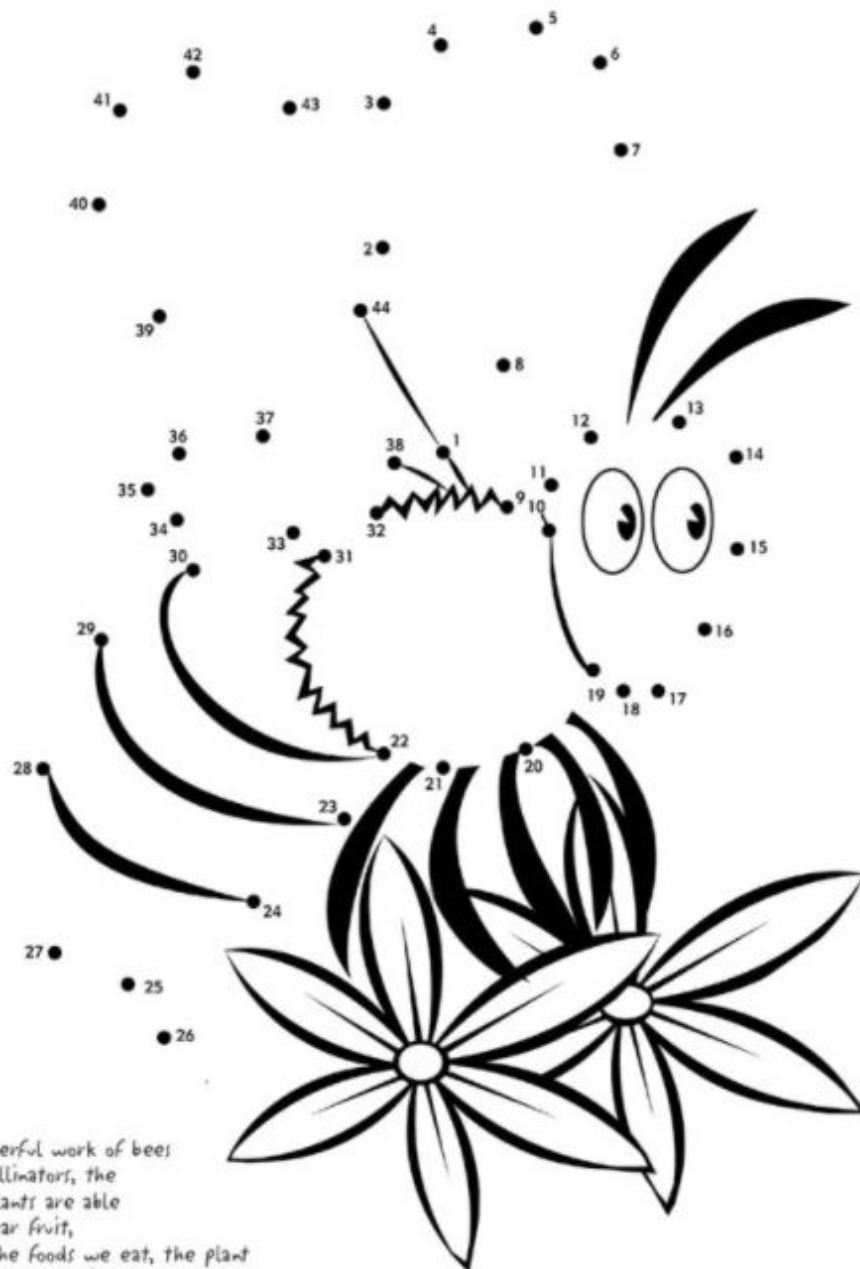
Can you help Barnaby work out if these are actions of a buddy or a bully? Colour in the happy face for a buddy and sad face for a bully

Pollinator



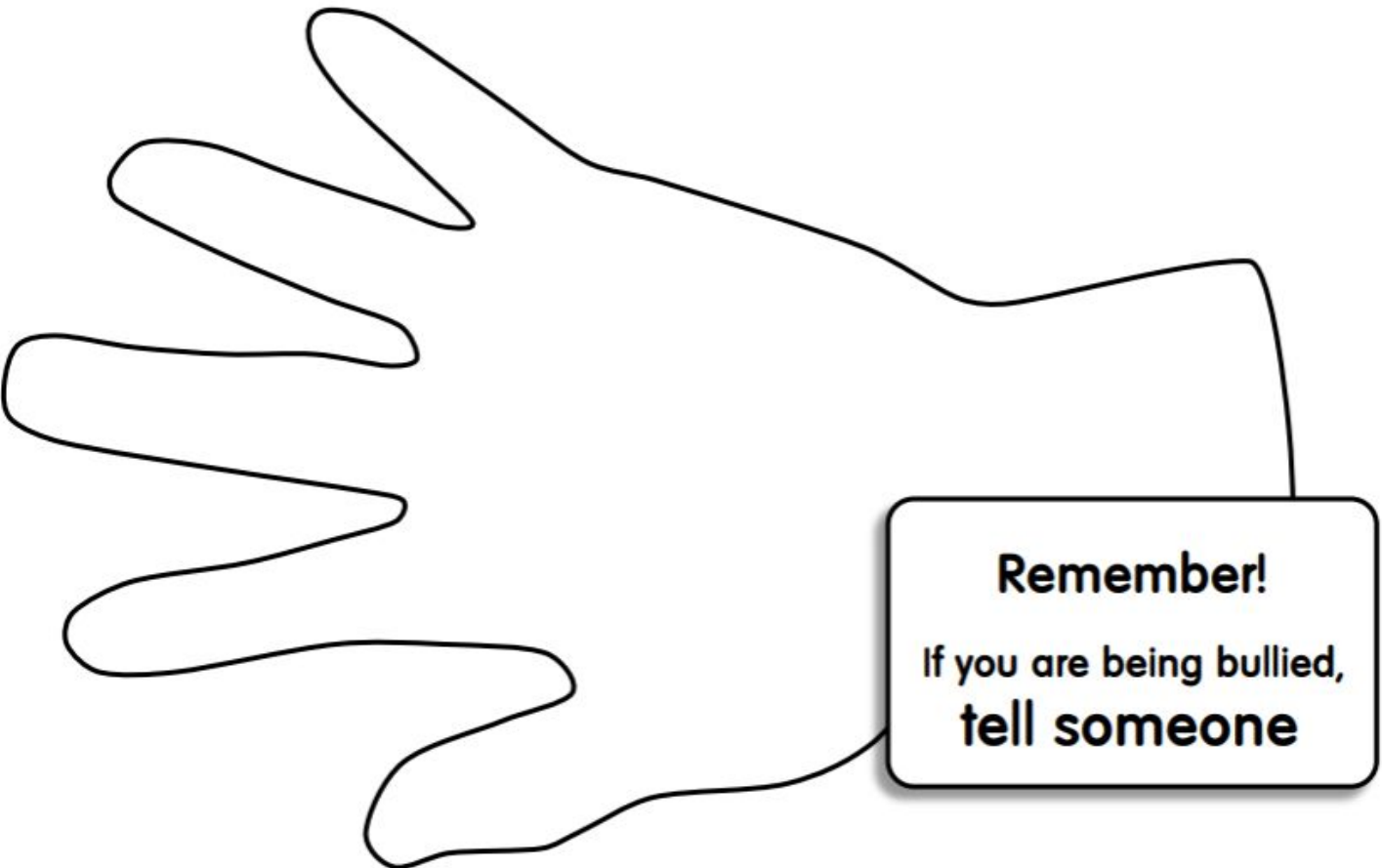

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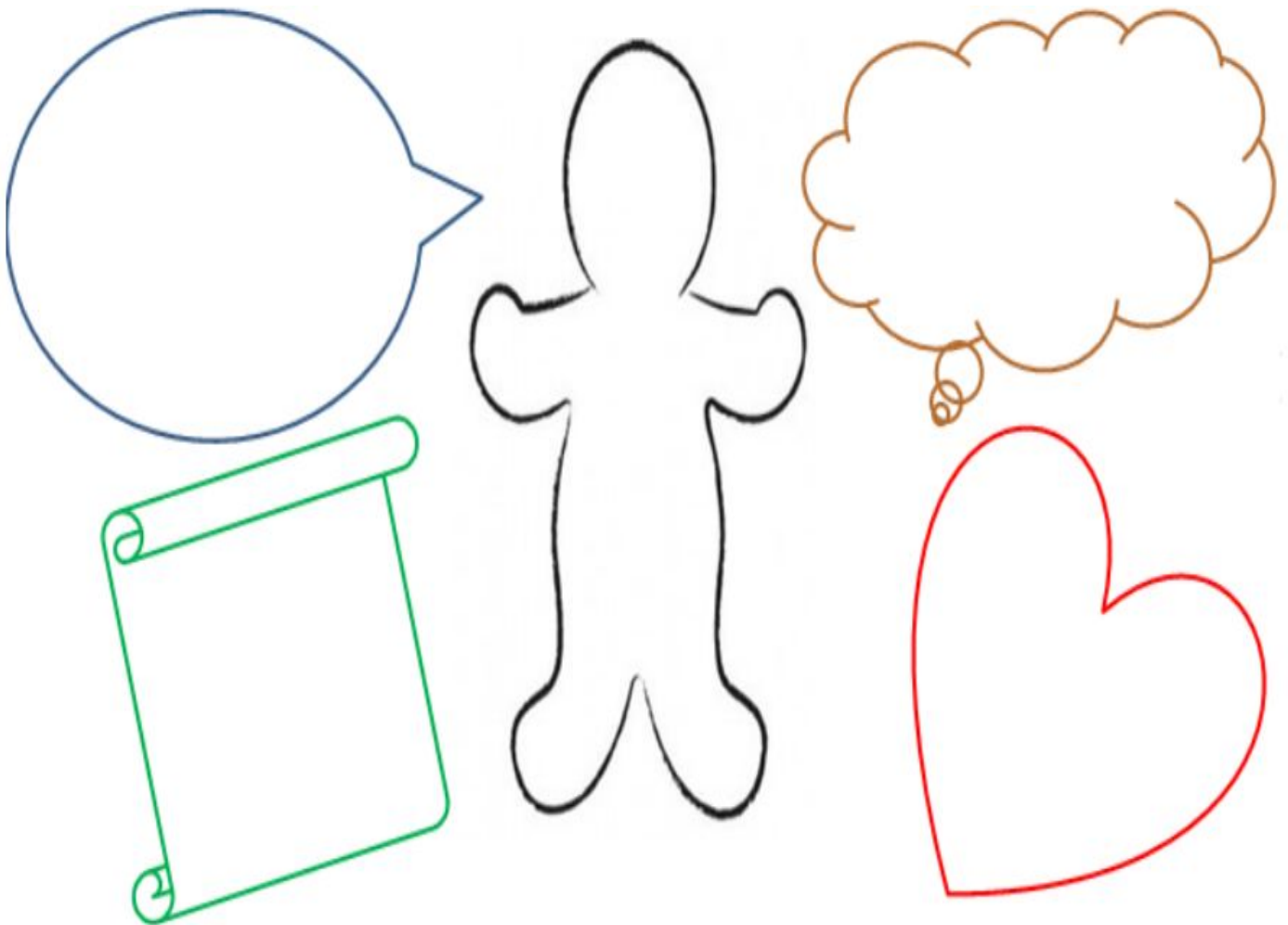
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# Activity 5

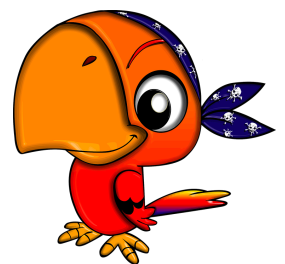
